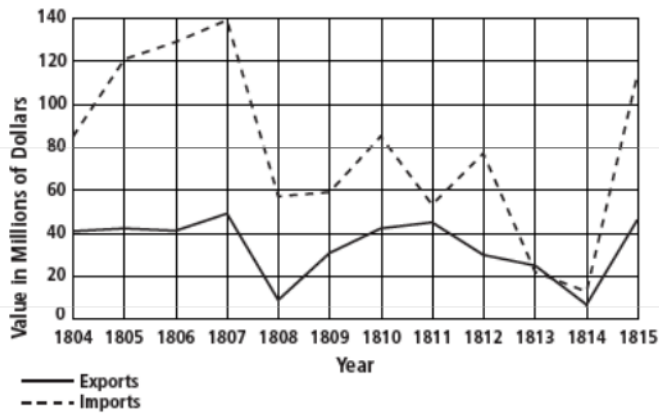

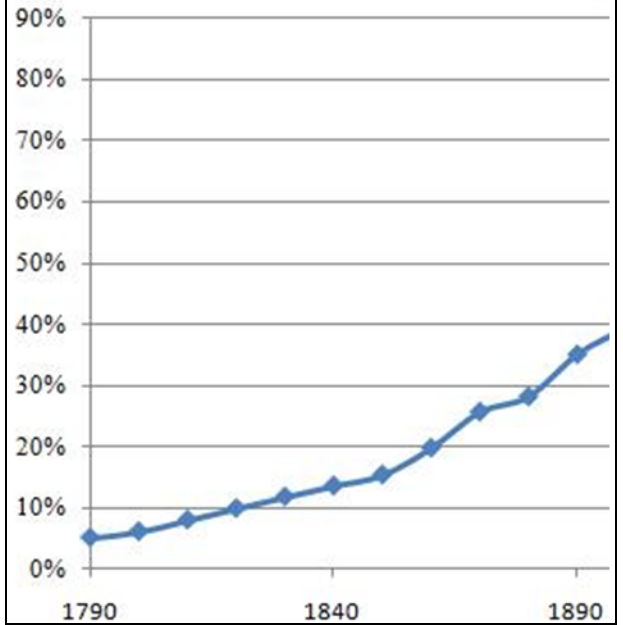
U.S. Imports and Exports, 1804–1815
