



## **Government Expenditures**

(2011 figures)

The total cost of the current bailout now exceeds \$23.8 trillion dollars. It has cost more than all of these government expenditures combined. Figures in parentheses have been adjusted for inflation:

- Marshall Plan: Cost: \$12.7 billion (\$115.3 billion)
- Louisiana Purchase: Cost: \$15 million (\$217 billion)
- Race to the Moon: Cost: \$36.4 billion (\$237 billion)
- S&L Crisis: Cost: \$153 billion (\$256 billion)
- Korean War: Cost: \$54 billion (\$454 billion)
- The New Deal: Cost: \$32 billion est.(\$500 billion est.)
- Invasion of Iraq: Cost: \$551billion (\$597 billion)
- Vietnam War: Cost: \$111 billion (\$698 billion)
- NASA: Cost: \$416.7 billion (\$851.2 billion)
