
What four words describe the people in the painting?

- Later you will participate in a class discussion centered around three questions about the effects of the colonila period on the founding ideals.




In the rectangle, create an advertisement encouraging British settlers and indentured servants to come to the colonies. Use simple images and a few phrases to make your message clear.
