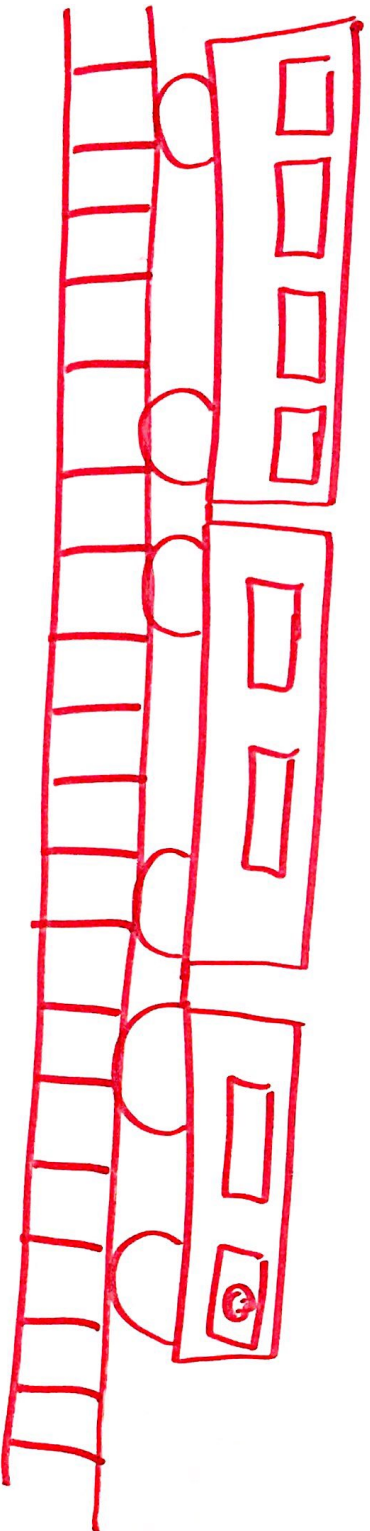


WORK, EXCHANGE, + ECON

- Louisiana purchase increased westward expansion

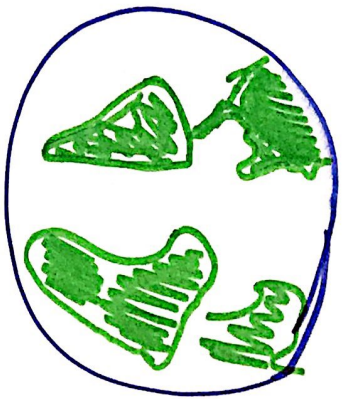


War of 1812

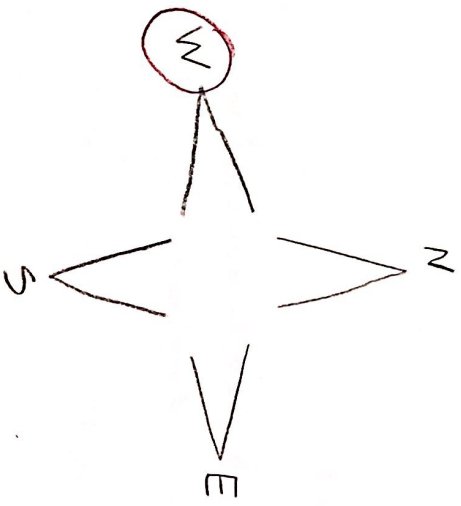

Transportation & Industrial Revolution

Revolution
