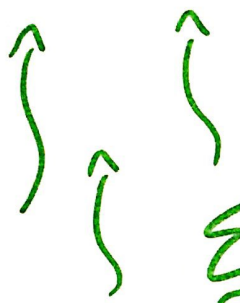

- Lewis + Clark

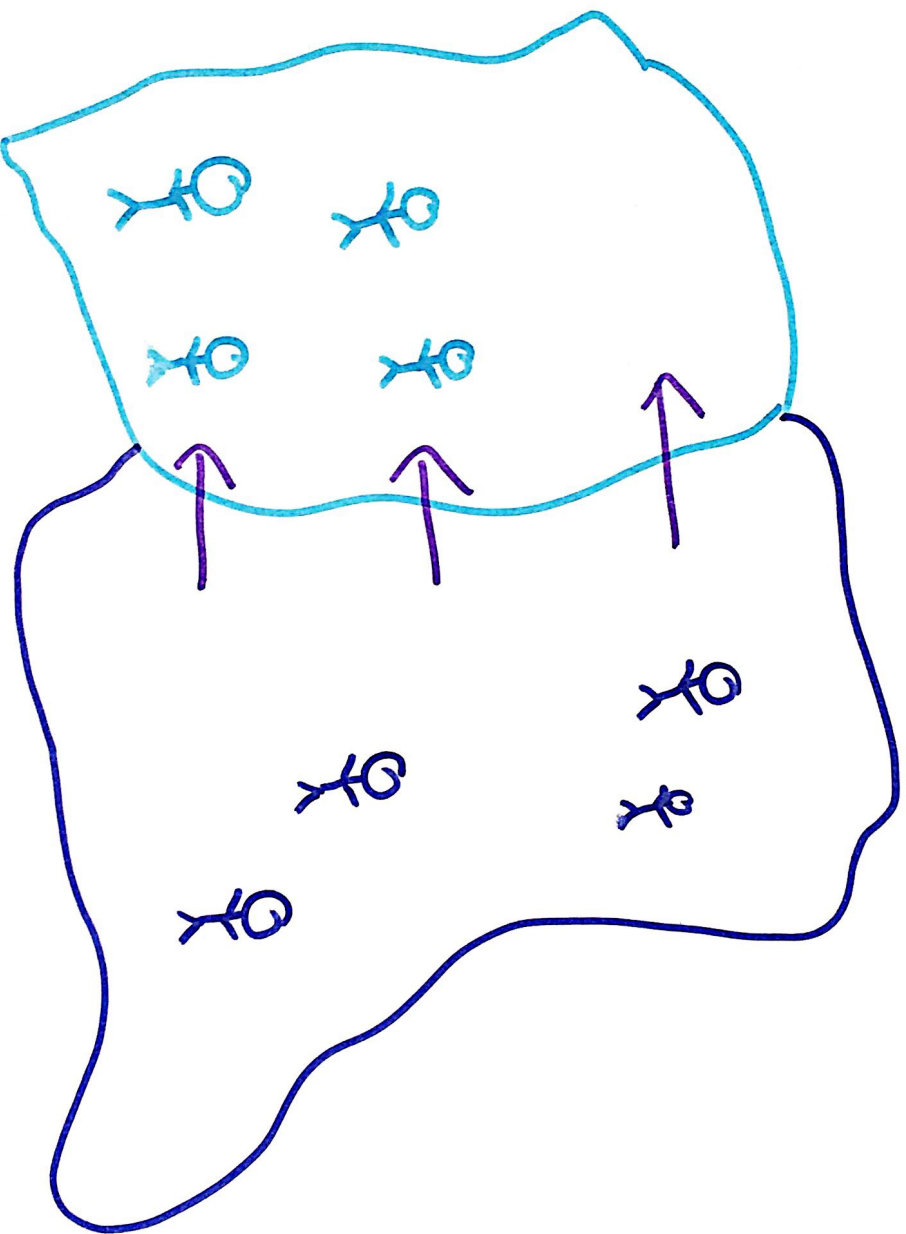
- documentation of new wildlife

gold rush - 1849, California

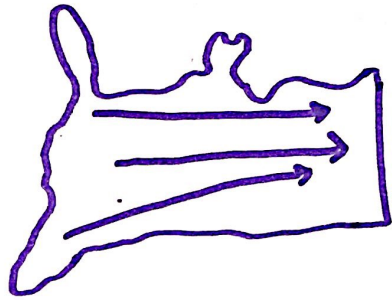
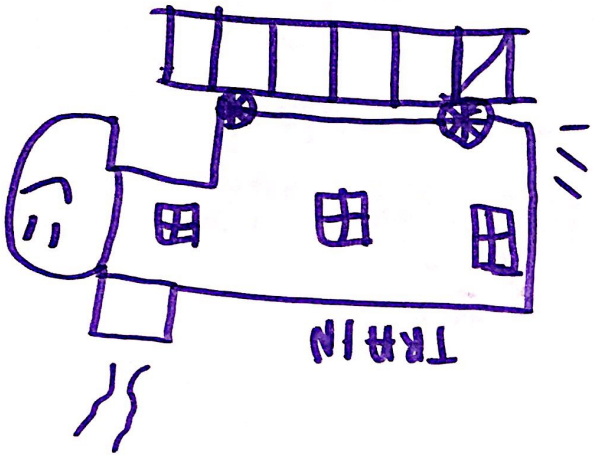


Work, Exchange and Technology

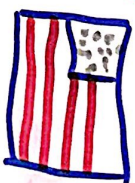
