Secondary & Primary Source Collection:

Imperialism & the Philippine War

For this discussion, you will be required to read and analyze a set of primary sources in addition to the reading selection from a historian. In order to make sure you are prepared for class discussions, you will also be required to complete the following written response, which you will turn in following the discussion for a portion of your grade:

For the historian's argument document:

- What is the author's primary thesis
- List the Main Ideas (You should be able to identify 2-3)
- Choose **two to three** passages or quotations from each selection that you would argue are the most significant. Explain why you chose each quotation.
- Create at least **two but no more than three** questions you would ask each **author**

For the Primary Sources:

- Identify 3-5 pieces of evidence in the sources and explain how each supports the author's assertion
- Identify an additional 3-5 pieces of evidence and explain how each supports an interpretation **OTHER THAN** the one asserted by this historian

Overall reflection

- Personal Reaction - A **ONE PARAGRAPH** response to the selection expressing your opinions based on what you have read, comparing it to the evidence in the provided sources **AND** to the other historical interpretations and sources you encountered in class.
- Create **at least three** questions you can ask **during class discussion** on the selection
